Eligibility:

- I. Active member of a Second Episcopal District A. M. E. Church and the Young Peoples Department.
- 2. Current Freshmen, Sophomore, or Junior pursuing a Bachelor's Degree
- 3. Current First-year college student pursuing an Associate or Technical Degree

Criteria for Selection:

- I. Academic performance
- 2. Quality and level of church participation
- 3. Leadership and extracurricular activities
- 4. TWO (2) Reference letters

Application Requirements:

- I. Completed application (typed or scanned into computer).

- 4. A competitive essay written in accordance with the current theme provided.

Applicants must submit all requested materials to the Second Episcopal District Education and Scholarship Chairperson (Mrs. Benay Hawkins) or her designee.

Applications must be accurate and completed according to the directions to be considered.

Essay must be type-written error free and written to the current theme. No application will be considered if it is

- (I) incomplete
- (2) missing references or signatures
- (3) containing the incorrect essay theme
- (4) missing current college transcript and/or
- (5) submitted after the deadline.

For each of the 5 SED Conferences, Book Scholarships will be awarded as follows:

First Place \$1000.00; 2nd place \$500.00; 3rd Place \$375.00

The Second Episcopal District Women Missionary Society Book Scholarship Essay Theme and Scoring Rubric

ESSAY THEME: Reflect on something that someone has done for you that made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?

As you think about your approach to the essay prompt, remember three things:

- Be <u>concise</u>
- · Be authentic (original)
- Provide <u>details</u>
- Essay should not exceed 500 words.
